Notice regarding Allocation list of electives

1. The National Medical Commission (NMC) regulations on Graduate Medical Education-2019 for MBBS course, effective from the academic Year 2019-20 onwards, have created an opportunity in the MBBS Programme for students to do electives, with the aim to stimulate enquiry, self-directed experiential learning and lateral thinking among students.
2. It is mandatory for the learners to do two electives (one in each block) of 15 days each. One month is designated for elective rotations after completion of the examination at the end of Third MBBS Part I and before commencement of Third MBBS Part II.
3. It is mandatory for learners to do the electives and the elective time shall not be used to make up for missed clinical postings, shortage of attendance or other purposes.
4. Minimum 75% attendance in each of the two blocks of electives and submission of log book maintained during both the blocks is required for eligibility to appear in the final MBBS examination.
5. During First 15 days, **FROM 01ST FEBRUARY 2025 TO 15TH FEBRUARY 2025** Roll Nos. 1-50 shall undergo electives in Block 1, while Roll Nos. 51-100 shall undergo electives in Block 2. During Second 15 days, **FROM 16TH FEBRUARY 2025 TO 02ND MARCH 2025** it shall be vice versa, i.e. Roll Nos. 1-50 shall undergo electives in Block 2, while Roll Nos. 51-100 shall undergo electives in Block 1

7. All HOD's should direct the internal preceptors (faculty members) to devise a daily time table for their respective elective module, in accordance with the previously specified learning objectives.
8. All HOD's would furnish a copy of the certificate of satisfactory completion of elective module, including fulfilment of minimum attendance criterion, duly signed by the preceptor, to Student Cell for further necessary action.
9. It is informed that the allocation of electives is final and cannot be changed/ modified.
10. In case of any queries, the students are advised to contact Dr.Megha Kulshreshtha, Associate Professor (Physiology) for Block 1 electives and Dr.Dipti Singh, Assistant Professor (ENT) for Block 2 electives.
